

STANDING RULES

A motion was made by Skip Reach to have only 2 Association credit cards (one for the Treasurer and the other for the Planning Chairman). (EBM 13 Feb 98)

The twelve phone cards are to be issued as needed. (EBM 13 Feb 98)

A list of attendees to the Trade Show will be made available to the participants upon request. (GBM 16 May 98)

Phone cards are to be issued to the President, Treasurer, Education, Membership, Planning, and Trade Show Chairman. (EBM 6 Nov 98)

The Trade Show will run \$20 for all visitors, which means anybody not in our association and that at any other of the three times it will be \$15 for any member from another locksmith association. (EBM 6 Nov 98)

Associate Members dues will be the same as for Regular Members. (EBM 6 Nov 98)

The association will not supply coffee or tea at the meetings unless a contract cannot be negotiated without them. (EBM 12 Feb 99)

Junior Apprentice will pay \$125 dues. (EBM 12 Feb 99)

Background color codes denoting Life (yellow), Board (blue) and Regular (white) membership will be used with the new ID. (EBM 9 Feb 01)

The logo with no border has been adopted as the official logo. (EBM 9 Feb 01)

Rooms for the President, Treasurer, Secretary, Education, and Host Coordinator chairman shall be paid for from Thursday - Saturday night. (EBM 9 Feb 01)

The old membership number will be reassigned even when there has been a time lapse. (EBM 18 May 01)

The Locksmith's Yard Sale will be held in August (Charlotte) and November (Raleigh) of even and odd years respectively. (EBM 10 Aug 01)

Directions will be enclosed with every meeting announcement. (EBM 10 Aug 01)

A web host can be facilitated for up to \$150 a year. (EBM 10 Aug 01)

Light red backgrounds will be used for visitors badges to the Trade Show. (EBM 30 Nov 01)

In the event of the death of a member in good standing \$200.00 is to be donated from the general fund to the survivor(s). (EBM 16 Aug 02)

The secretary is also authorized to order flowers when necessary. (EBM 16 Aug 02)

Paid classes can be set up with a \$75.00 limit per student without board approval. More than one paid class per meeting can be held with board approval with the association matching if necessary up to the fee. (EBM 17 Aug 02)

Two mandatory subjects are required for all apprentices to take: Basic Safe Servicing and Basic Masterkeying. They will be offered once a year. (GBM 16 Aug 02)

Our name is to be put on The Infrastructure Security Partnership list. (EBM 8 Nov 02)

A locksmith referral database of members who give their permission is to be created and added to the website. (GBM 9 Nov 02)

POC for problems with the hotel will be the president, planning chairman, and secretary. (EBM 7 Feb 03)

Each business will receive one free photo album and additional copies may be purchased at cost. (EBM 7 Feb 03)

A NCLLB Liaison Committee was established with Steve Bright named as Chairman. (EBM 7 Feb 03)

The Locksmith's Yard Sale will be held after the business meeting annually in May beginning in 2005. (EBM 8 Aug 03)

In February pictures for members will be taken on Friday only and there will be a separate line for registering visitors on Saturday. (GBM 9 Aug 03)

\$10.00 from every nonmember registration and \$10.00 from each class that the nonmember attends is to be set aside in a special contingency fund plus donations from the general membership to be utilized as the executive board deems necessary effective May 2004. (EBM 6 Feb 04)

The Video Library will be the responsibility of the Education Committee to try to centralize that. (EBM 4 June 04)

The board luncheon will be put on the credit card. (EBM 4 June 04)

There will be a \$10.00 dubbing fee if a tape is not returned in good working order and said member will not be able to renew their membership until such debt is satisfied. (EBM 6 Aug 04)

Cost to replace the new ID will be \$10.00. (EBM 10 Nov 04)

The NC Locksmith's Assoc., Inc. will provide facilities at our meetings for the PRP certification examination twice a year in May & November and the NCLLB quarterly free of charge. (GBM 12 Feb 05)

The new hours for the Trade Show will be 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM. (GBM 12 Feb 05)

The secretary's salary will be increased to \$500.00 per quarter and the assistant secretary will be compensated \$150.00 per quarter. (EBM 13 May 05)

The Trade Show is allowed up to \$2500.00 operational budget. (EBM 13 May 05)

The Trade Show Chairman's room will be paid for at the February meeting.
